

The Palomar Knot



1. Double about 4" of line and pass loop through eye.



2. Let hook hang loose and tie overhand knot in doubled line. Avoid twisting and don't tighten knot.



3. Pull loop of line far enough to pass it over hook, swivel or lure. Make sure loop passes completely over this attachment



4. Pull both tag end and standing line to tighten. Clip about 1/8" from knot.

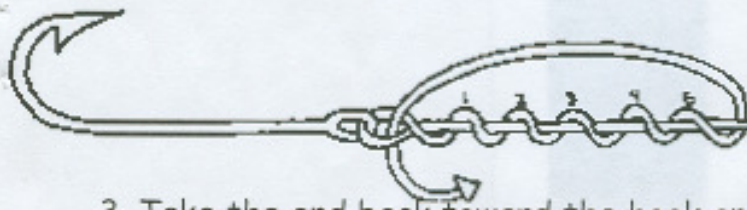
The Clinch Knot



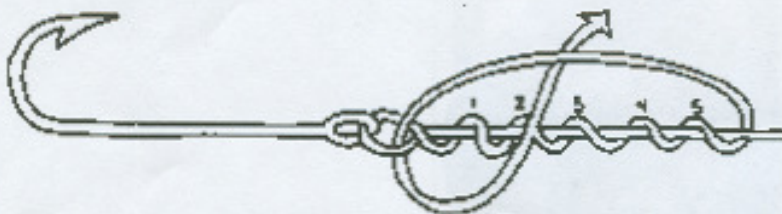
1. Put the end of the line through the eye of the hook and bring it back toward the line.



2. Make five twists around the line.



3. Take the end back toward the hook and push it through the first loop nearest the eye,



4. Bring the end back through the big loop.



5. Carefully holding the hook and the line, pull the knot tight until it looks like the knot shown.
